 - Focus on priorities

- Build road maps
- Across various time horizons and actors
- Identify roadblocks: R&D&I priorities

Facilitate Collaborative R&D&I Execution

- Feed priorities into project calls
- Identify networks of excellence
- Forum to broker collaborative projects addressing priorities

ENI² & CATRENE Scientific Committee

- CATRENE Board decision during ENF 2014
 move CSC activities to ENI2 under Common Support Group supervision
- Organization : merge CSC into ENI² steering committee
- Activities
 - ENI² to continue yearly study of a specific application domain – report and dissemination workshop
 - For 2015, follow-up of the "Smart City" report
 - Select a focus area from the report recommendations
